NCEA Level 1 English (101, 102)

In 2019 at Level 1 there is one mainstream English class (101), and an accelerated learning class (102). Students are placed into these cases based on reading and writing results from 2018. These courses are made up of SEVEN achievement standards, producing credits, 13 of which are assessed internally and 12 by external exam at the end of the year.

For 101 and 102, There three compulsory internally assessed achievement standards: 1.6, 1.8 and 1.11
Students will do ALL of these assessments

101: There is also the choice of 1.4 creative writing or 1.5 formal writing. STUDENTS CHOOSE ONLY ONE
102: 1.4 Creative Writing and 1.5 formal Writing: STUDENTS COMPLETE BOTH

There is the possibility of entry in THREE externally assessed achievement standards: 1.1, 1.2, 1.3

To advance to Level 2, a student must achieve *12 credits in the external exam OR 14 credits overall, including at least on standard in the external examination.*

Endorsement is able to be achieved in this course.
