NCEA Level 3 English (301)

This course is made up of SIX achievement standards and ONE unit standard.
FOUR are internal and THREE by external exam at the end of the year.

There are THREE compulsory internally assessed standards: 3.4, 3.5 and US22750

During the year there will be ONE resubmission opportunity to be assessed for all standards, if the student is very close to achieving the standard. Feedback will be given at the time of the exercise and candidates are urged to take advantage of this.

3.7 and 3.9 : Students choose which standard they wish to complete, either a close viewing assessment, or a connections assessment, utilising the texts covered over the course of the year.

There are THREE externally assessed achievement standards: 3.1, 3.2, 3.3 - Students will choose 1 or 2 of these depending on individual need

This subject is a recognised domain for NCEA Level Three. The unit standard does not count towards the domain but can be used for the 6 credit writing portfolio
