It relates to tectonic (crust movement, earthquakes etc.) factors that have created fault lines, uplifted areas (scarps) and explains the reasons for the shape and existence of Wellington's hills and valley landscape. Also, how human settlement recognises the dangers of living a grade one active fault line and the certainty of earthquakes.
- \* The prerequisite for entry into Year 1 Geography is a reasonable standard of achievement in Year 10 and ability to handle an examination and internally assessed course.
