Māori 101

- Any trip costs that the class will attend must be covered by the students. All Māori trips will be local. Whānau must pay the NCEA fee of \$75, \$20 with a Community Services card, for the student's credits to count in the year of their achievement otherwise there will be a late fee added.
- Māori 101 offers students a maximum of 30 credits, 18 of those credits being internal, Listening, Speaking and Creative writing. 12 credits are external, Writing and Reading.
- The pre requisite for level 2 will be at least 18 credits at level 1
- The chance for reassessment of standards is at the discretion of the TIC of Māori and will take place during the students own time. There will be no class time allocated for reassessments or other resubmissions. Due to the large amount of assessment in the senior school and in each subject, the option of reassessment or resubmission will be valid in the term that it is initially submitted in. Students must endeavour to use the opportunities of Homework Club and their own tutor time to prepare themselves for reassessment and resubmission.
