## TOURISM LEVEL 3

Level 3 Tourism is a course that is provided by the Industry Training Organisation for students who are interested in a career in the Travel Industry. The course is designed to provide the background knowledge required for students wishing to pursue Travel and Careers Training in the future

Booklets and assessments are provided by the Industry and students are able to work through them at their own pace. Students need to be self-motivated and have good attendance to achieve well in this course.

### TOURISM TRIPS

The topic in Term Two is **Australia** and as part of this topic the students will plan and design an itinerary for a class trip to the Gold Coast in Queensland, Australia. This trip will take place at the start of term three and is an **optional** not compulsory part of the course. The trip is subsidised and the cost to the students is expected to be around **\$750**. More information about the proposed trip will be sent as soon as the dates are confirmed.

For those who are unable to attend the trip to Australia we may be able to offer an alternative day trip to **Auckland** at a subsidised cost of approximately **\$75** per student.
